

MAINTENANCE ADVICE

Normal cleaning

- Vacuum regularly, ideally every other week, at half power where possible. Wipe upholstery made of polyurethane clean with a dry or slightly damp cloth. If necessary, you can also vacuum with a soft brush.
- Plastic and aluminium components can be washed with a microfibre cloth and a little water.

Stain removal

It is not difficult to remove stains and prevent them from forming if you act quickly. However, we cannot guarantee that the stains will be fully removed.

- First scrape off any liquids or hardened residues with a spoon or scraper before proceeding. All loose particles must be vacuumed before further cleaning.
- Liquids must be soaked up with an absorbent napkin or cloth.
- Remove non-greasy stains by carefully dabbing with a lint-free cloth or sponge that has been squeezed in warm water. Stains on the edges can be avoided by dabbing gently in a circular motion towards the centre of the stain, with a clean, lint-free cloth.
- Remove greasy stains with suitable detergents or solvents. In all cases we recommend to first test stain removers on an inconspicuous area to see if this has no adverse effect.

Tips

- First make sure that the fabric is completely dry before reusing it. You may also need to use a hair dryer in order to leave no stains behind on the edges. This is especially true for microfibre textiles.
- Due to the excessive use of paint in jeans, dark jeans can leave stains on textiles. Washing and/or cleaning may not always give satisfactory results. Stains of jeans on polyurethane products can be removed using a rubber. Warning – Do not rub the material too hard because this may cause colour loss or damage to the surface.
- Be careful with solvents; they can dissolve the underlying upholstery materials. You may never use concentrated detergents or bleach, ammonia or soap that is intended for hard surfaces.

In conclusion

These tips are just recommendations and cannot guarantee complete stain removal. In all cases we recommend getting in touch with a professional cleaning firm. To ensure satisfactory results, specifically for large stains, we recommend contacting a professional washing business. It is important to mention whether the stain has already been treated.
